The charity course is for students who want more than a General English course this summer.

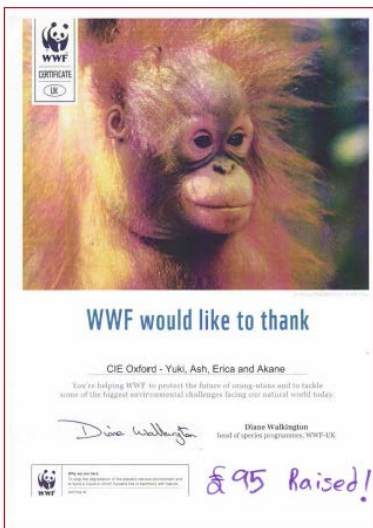
This course is an excellent opportunity to learn English whilst gaining valuable skills in research, presentation skills and event organisation.
