For example, children under the age of 16 must be home by 22.00 each night; if they leave their home after dark they must inform their host family where they are going; they must not enter a pub or club; they must not drink alcohol, smoke cigarettes or take illegal drugs. Please see the pre-arrival information for more information about rules on curfews for different age groups.

If your child visits a friend/relative they must have the school's permission and they must inform the school and host family of their travel plans and who they are going to visit. The friend/relative must collect your child and return them to the homestay.

- Your child must attend all classes. The school has a strict attendance policy. Students may be absent only if they are unwell. In such cases, the student or their host family must telephone the school as soon as possible on the day of the illness.
- The school's social programme is not compulsory, nor is it specifically designed for this age group from September to June. Certain activities are not suitable for students under 18. All school social activities are supervised by school staff who can assist the students attending the activity. We strongly advise all students to return to their host family with a friend, or preferably by taxi, particularly in the evening when it is dark. - In the interests of student welfare, in July and August the school will provide lunch with extra charge for all under 18 students who are either taking afternoon classes or activities, and this lunch will be provided on the school premises. Students are also advised to bring enough money for transport in Oxford.
- All students under the age of 16 **MUST** have a return airport taxi transfer, unless they are travelling with a named relative.
- The school reserves the right to terminate the course of any student who seriously or persistently misconducts himself/herself during his/her stay
