If your child visits a friend/relative they must have the school's permission and they must inform the school and host family of their travel plans and who they are going to visit. The friend/relative must collect your child and return them to the homestay.

Your child must attend all classes. The school has a strict attendance policy. Students may be absent only if they are unwell. In such cases, the student or their host family must telephone the school as soon as possible on the day of the illness.

The school's social programme is not compulsory, nor is it specifically designed for this age group from September to June. Certain activities are not suitable for students under 18. All school social activities are supervised by school staff who can assist the students attending the activity. We strongly advise all students to return to their host family with a friend, or preferably by taxi, particularly in the evening when it is dark.

All students under the age of 16 **MUST** have a return airport taxi transfer, unless they are travelling with a named relative.

The school reserves the right to terminate the course of any student who seriously or persistently misconducts himself/herself during his/her stay.

Once you submit the enrolment form, the deposit would be required to arrange to school.
(Your invoice will be sent by email from school so please arrange the deposit or full payment to confirm your booking.)

Deposit:

A deposit of £100 (NB. If you need a Visa to enter in UK for studying, the deposit will be a minimum of £500.)

Balance payment:

The full payment is required 4 weeks before the student arrives.
