Summer locations

Our Senior students will study at our CIE main campus on St Michael's Street, right in the middle of the city centre surrounded by shops, markets and restauarnts. Most of our adult students will usually have been carefully selected a home stay family to live with.



Our Junior students (aged 12-17) will study at our new summer school location at City of Oxford College. Residential junior students will stay a ten minute walk away at Cherwell accommodation, where they will each have their own room and their own bathroom.

Both residential and non residential juniors will have lunch at the college, but breakfast and dinner will be at the residency. Weekend meals will all be at the residency, including a packed lunch.



Junior Accommodation

Our students aged 12-17 will reside at Cherwell House – a purpose-built student residential accommodation located within a short walking distance from City of Oxford College and the Westgate shopping centre. The boarding facilities comprise of 55 single en-suite study bedrooms with a residential welfare team responsible for the students' pastoral care and wellbeing.

FACILITIES INCLUDE:

- En-suite (single) student rooms
- Dining room
- Full-board catering (freshly prepared meals)
- Water coolers
- Student common area
- Laundry room
- Medical room
- Weekly housekeeping/cleaning (linen, bedding, and towels supplied and cleaned weekly)
- Wi-Fi
- Outside garden
- Bike storage



Homestay (15+)

Students aged 15 and above can stay in homestay accommodation. We have carefully selected host families who are experienced at looking after students of all ages. You will have breakfast and the evening meal with the family. During mealtimes you can chat with your host family about your day and life in England. Our students often keep in touch with their host families long after the summer is over.



Across all of our accommodation, students are expected to keep their bedrooms tidy and take their rubbish to the communal bin area and maintain a reasonable standard of cleanliness in accommodation.




